

Fredy Koller (alias Francis Rossi) has been pursuing the idea of forming a STATUS QUO tribute Band since the 80s.

Considerable success with his former band TRANSIT, including chart positions in Europe and Japan, shaped the necessary basis for this new project. Finally, in 2010 the Quo-project got launched.

Delivering the typical rhythm guitar sound Tom Cassy (Rick Parfitt) represents the ingenious addition to this tribute band.

Louis Kasper on bass (John Edwards), and Bat Ming on drums (Leon Cave) can also look back on many years of stage experience and countless gigs.

The well-known producer and director Kuno Bont managed to put on stage a rock opera with Station Quo in Buchs/ Switzerland in 2013. The rock opera "Whatever You Want" was a huge success and all ten shows were completely sold out.

STATION QUO does not only epitomise a feast for the ears. The stage show is reproduced very true to the original of the great and legendary British rockers and is being rehearsed down to the tiniest details. Of course, the famous white Marshall amps and lookalike green and white telecasters are being used in the stage set-up.

Station Quo offers the unique chance of exuberant groove-orgies with air guitars on days when the great kings of boogie rock happen not to be on tour.
